

Permerbeck

History...

For nearly 350 years – from 1645 to 1991 – this property on Rossmarkt was home to the baking trade and was passed on from generation to generation along with the “*Bäckergerechtigkeit*” (baker’s licence).

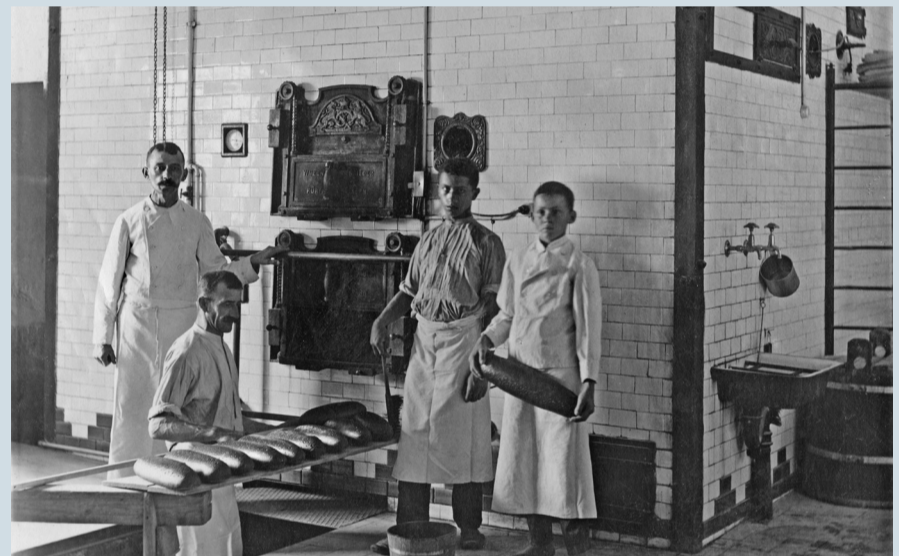
Thus, in 1700, Franz Westermayr handed over the entire property to his son Michael for 3,400 guilders. Michael received the building including the bakehouse, along with 6 woven tablecloths, 1 pewter measuring jug, 1 dozen wooden plates, and copper and iron pans. The father retained the top-floor parlour, kitchen and 2 bedrooms as his “*Austrag*” (old man’s part).

130 years later, the property was purchased by Johann Reim of the neighbouring “*Stieglbeck*” bakery in Augsburgstrasse. He and his descendants operated the bakery until 1964. Thereafter, relatives from Traunstein took over the bakery, commissioned a new building in 1971/72 and opened a café on the first floor.

Following various different uses in recent years, the baking trade returned here in 2019. Alongside the bread and pastry shop there is now a small snack bar and café.

... and a story

In the mid-18th century, the unmarried and in some cases underage children of the widowed baker Michael Mayr were still living here. The father was officially notified: *... it being apparent that the existing house is not being improved and that parts of the barn are also beginning to come down*, it was necessary to look for a respectable marriage within two months or sell the house. Thus, in 1749, his twenty-year-old daughter Maria married the baker Johann Hainz of Hölching.
